

# THE MASTERS IN TEACHING AND LEARNING

The Workforce Agreement Monitoring Group (WAMG)<sup>1</sup> is the body representing Government, employers and the majority of school workforce trade unions/professional associations. WAMG is working in partnership with the Training and Development Agency for Schools (TDA) to ensure the successful establishment of the Masters in Teaching and Learning (MTL).

A central purpose of professional development is to enhance teachers' knowledge, confidence and skills as a basis for improving outcomes for pupils. The fully-funded MTL provides an excellent opportunity for schools to deliver professional development for teachers through an accredited school-based programme. Supporting the MTL should also benefit participating schools in helping to further embed a culture of lifelong learning for all staff.

WAMG encourages school leaders in eligible schools in England to support teachers to enrol on the MTL for 2010.
